1. $y(x) = e^{-x}(c_1 \cos 2x + c_2 \sin 2x)$

2. $y(t) = c_1 \cos 2t + c_2 \sin 2t - \frac{1}{5} \cos 3t$

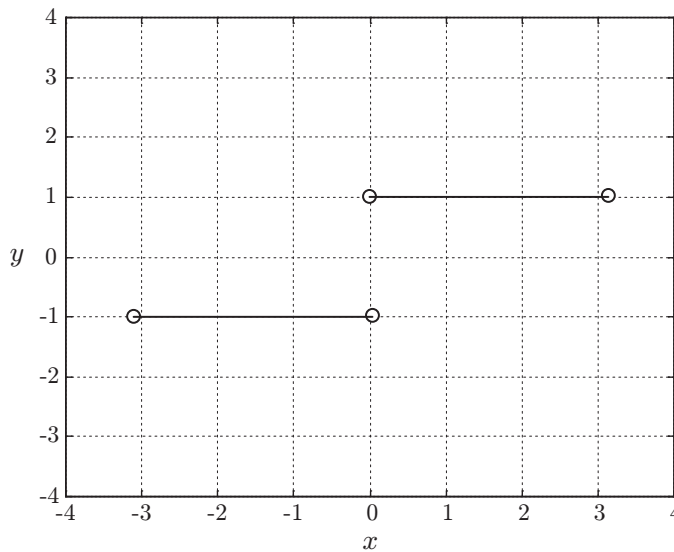
3. $y(x) = \left(\frac{1}{2}x + 2\right)^2$

4. $y(x) = \frac{1}{2}x + \frac{1}{2x}$

5. not applicable

6. (a) $Y(s) = \frac{1}{s+2} + \frac{e^{-3s}}{s(s+2)}$

(b) $y(t) = e^{-2t} + \frac{1}{2}u(t-3) - \frac{1}{2}e^{-2(t-3)}u(t-3)$

8. $u(x, t) = e^{-2t} \sin x + \frac{1}{3}e^{-18t} \sin 3x$
