## Summer Enrichment Workshop in Mathematics 090

Meets Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday 2:00 PM-5:00 PM in SEO 521

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• Description: This course is an accelerated program in Intermediate Algebra for incoming freshmen, designed to provide students with the necessary background to enroll in College Algebra, Math 110 at UIC in the Fall.

- Grades: The course is graded S/U (Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory). A grade of S will result in permission to enroll in Math 110 in Fall 2016. A grade of U will require the student to take Math 090, or Math 090/088, or Math 118/075. A final grade of 70% is necessary for a grade of S. Any final grade lower than 70% will result in a U. Here is the breakdown of points for the course:
  - Written Homework: Written homework assignments will be given each week and due typically due Thursdays. These will be averaged to count as 30% of your final grade.
  - Worksheets: Each day in class, you will complete worksheets together with your classmates. The worksheet is designed to prepare you for the homework. There is no credit associated to the worksheet, you won't turn it in, and you will take it home to refer to while working on the homework. However, your completion of the worksheet will count into your attendance and participation grade, which is 10% of the final grade.
  - **Exams:** There will be two exams: one midterm (July 24) and one final (August 3). Each will be worth 30% of the final grade, for a total of 60% of the final grade.
- Attendance and participation: Because of the fast pace of the course, you are required to attend all classes. In addition to attendance, you will complete worksheets every day in class, with the help of your peers. Your participation grade will be based on your completed worksheet, and your willingness to help your peers, present problems at the board, and ask and answer questions of the instructor. Excused absences may occur at the discretion of the instructor. Please let your instructor know before your absence.
- Makeup Exams and homework: You are required to attend all exams. Makeup exams or homework may only be granted by prior consent and arrangement with the instructor..
- Calculators: The use of calculators on *any* part of this course (exams, worksheets, homework) is strictly **prohibited**. All materials related to this course are designed to be completed without a calculator.
