Give code to set up a web server that can handle an indefinite number of requests and shuts down when the user presses `ctrl+c`. Web browsers connect to the server via `http://localhost:8888/`. The server maintains an anydbm file with name `'/tmp/data????'` where `????` are four random digits. The anydbm file has one field `'count'` that stores the total number of requests handled by the server. For every request made by a browser, the user sees in the browser window the message `"welcome, visitor n"` where `n` is 0 for the first visitor and 1 for the second visitor, etc.
